

Registering a Foal

After your purebred Shetland foal is born, the following is the procedure for registration:

1. If you are a new breeder, check you have applied for a Stud Prefix and Firebrand and that these have been accepted. **Note:** All ponies must have a Stud Prefix. Your Stud Prefix will precede the pony's name; eg. if your Stud Prefix is 'Highbank' and you wish to call your pony 'Hamish'. = 'Highbank Hamish' will be the pony's name on the Application of Registration form.
2. Your foal must be branded prior to weaning (see below).
3. An Application for Registration form must be completed (available from the secretary or from the web site).
4. Applications must be submitted within 12 months of foaling
5. Breeders are to fill in all information and return the Application for Registration form to the secretary, along with the correct fee. The Certificate of Service section must be filled in by the stallion owner.
6. Foal or adult applications can only be made by financial members of the Society.
7. Your foal may only be registered with the NZSPBS if it is the progeny of a registered Shetland sire and dam.
8. **Fees are as follows:**
 - Females:** \$20 - Full registration Certificate will be issued.
 - Geldings:** \$10 - Full registration Certificate will be issued.
 - Colts:** \$10 - Colts remain on the temporary foal registration record until 2-4 years of age when: -

Stallion Registration: (\$300) must be applied for and the pony must pass a veterinary inspection (forms available from the secretary). If the Colt is sold as an Entire while still Foal Recorded, the \$300 must be pre-paid by the vendor before transfer is accepted. The secretary must be advised if the colt is gelded.
