Colts \$10 Colts remain on the temporary foal register until they are:

Amount Paid:

(a) Gelded - in which case the Secretary must be advised accordingly. A full Registration certificate will then be issued at no extra charge, **or**

Stallions \$300

(b) Until they are aged between two and four years, or are used for stud duties. At this time, Full Registration must be applied for and the stallion must pass the veterinary certificate of soundness. Adult registration forms and certificate of soundness forms are available at no extra charge, **or**

(c) Sold as an Entire. The \$300 fee is paid by the vendor before transfer is completed. Thus the vendor, by not gelding the colt, is standing by his/her opinion that the animal is top quality and suitable for breeding purposes. If the colt is subsequently gelded or dies prior to serving mares or being adult registered, or does not pass veterinary inspection, 80% of registration fee will be refunded to the owner.

1. Applications must be submitted within 12 months of foaling.
2. Breeders are to fill in all information correctly and return to the secretary with payment.
3. Foal or Adult Application can only be made from financial members of the Society
4. Certificate of Service, on reverse, must be completed by stallion owner.
5. This Registration application must be accompanied by two colour photographs of the pony, that clearly show both near side and offside brands and markings.

Please complete the Registration form in full (including details of markings) AND attach the photos. The photos must fulfill the following requirements:-

- ♣ The pony must constitute at least 80% of the photograph. ♣ The brands on both sides must be clearly visible.(best taken at time of branding) ♣ Photos must be 15cm x 10cm (6 inches x 4 inches) in size. ♣ Photos must be in colour.
- ♣ You must write the intended registered name of the pony and sign the back of each photo (photos may inadvertently get separated from your form) ♣ Emailed photos or photos on disk will not be accepted
- ♣ Photos must be originals and must not be digitally manipulated.

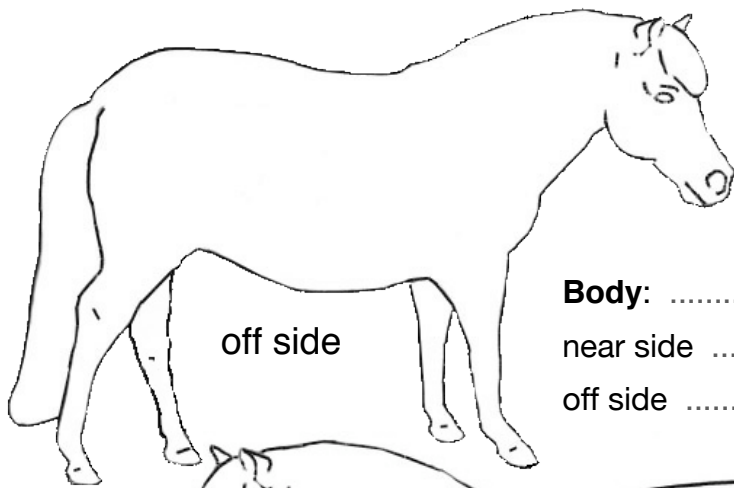

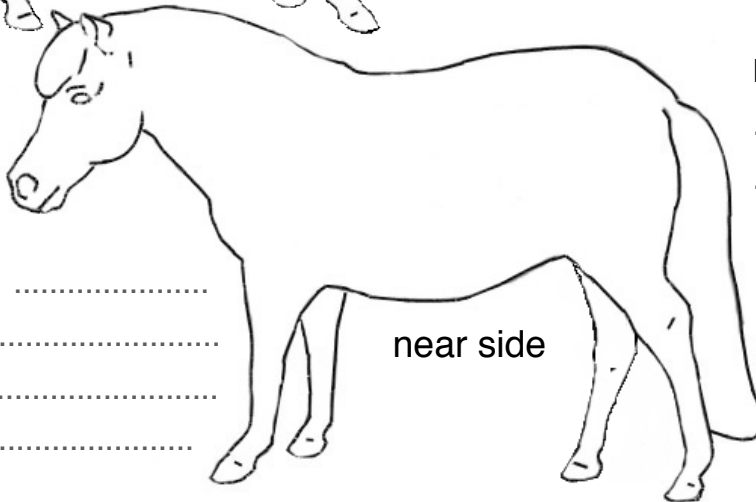
